

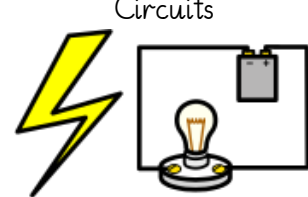
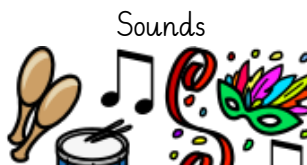
Subject Vocab Check

Maths	perpendicular lines	Perpendicular lines are two straight lines that intersect at a perfect 90° angle.
Science	circuit	A completed path for an electrical current.
D&T	appliqué	A decorative needlework technique where smaller pieces of fabric are attached to a larger base fabric.
History	mummification	The process of preserving a dead body as a mummy.
R.E.	prayer	An act of communication with the sacred, typically involving petitions, thanksgiving, or praise.
Art	illustrator	A person who draws or creates pictures for magazines, books, advertising, etc.
Music	samba	A lively, rhythmic Afro-Brazilian music and dance style.
P.E.	bowling	Throwing the ball underarm at waist height towards the batter.
French	la natation	swimming
Computing	transition	How a slide moves from one to the next.
