




Subject Vocab Check

History	forge	a place to heat and melt metal to allow objects to be made
R.E.	pilgrimage	a journey to a special place that is important for religious reasons
Computing	LOGO	a text-based coding language used to control an on screen turtle to create mathematical patterns
Art	coiling	a method of creating pottery where long rolls of clay are coiled, then joined on top of each other using slip
Music	ballad	a story written in short phrases which are called stanzas
PSHE	neurodiversity	the range of differences in an individual's brain function
