KS1 Visit to Gulliver's Valley, Sheffield Wednesday 17th June 2026

Dear Parent/ Carer

The children in Key Stage 1 will be visiting Gulliver's Valley on Wednesday 17th June 2026. We will be leaving school at around 9.30 am, so children will need **to arrive at school for 8.30 am**. We will be returning to school at around **3.00 pm** ready for our usual collection time. If there is a chance that we will return any later than this time, we will inform you via ClassDojo. Please ensure that your child is wearing their school uniform as usual for this trip. However, they may wish to wear alternative footwear, such as trainers, as there is some walking involved.

As all Key Stage 1 children receive free school meals, school will provide a packed lunch for all children on this visit so you will not need to send your child with any lunch on this day. Sandwich options will need to be pre-ordered by clicking on the link below and completing the form by **Friday 5th June**.

Children will however need **a drink for lunchtime AND a bottle of water for the day**. Children will also be expected to carry their own things during the day so **they will need to bring these items in a suitable small bag or rucksack** as this will make it much easier for the children to carry.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£17.00** towards the cost of the trip. If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium Grant, there is a discount of 25% and the contribution is **£12.75**. This includes transport and entry to Gulliver's Valley. **There will be no need for any spending money.**

Please log into ParentPay to make payment and to give permission for your child to take part.

Please speak to the School Office if your child will need any medication during this visit, e.g. travel sickness pills or inhalers and contact your child's class teacher if there is anything else they need to know in relation to this trip.
