Dear Parents and Carers

At St Andrew's, we want all our pupils to enjoy maths and have confidence in their ability in the subject because studies have shown that children who enjoy maths and have confidence in the subject also have a quick recall of times tables facts.

To support the quick recall of times tables facts, all children have access to 'Times Table Rockstars' to help them practise their times tables. 'Times Table Rockstars' is an online programme for times table practice that is both effective and motivational. Your child will have a login and password that will allow them to access games at home to improve their speed of recall and, should they wish, to compete against their classmates and children around the world.

To celebrate the 'Times Table Rockstars' league that has been running across Key Stage Two, and to support the Year 4 children in the lead up to their multiplication check, we will be holding a 'Rockstars Day' on Friday 22nd May. Throughout the final week of the half term, we will be holding different times tables-based competitions for the children to take part in. They will compete to improve their own personal speed and scores as well as against other classes and children in school.

On 22nd May, we will have a celebration day where the children may come to school dressed as rockstars. As part of the day, there will be chance to 'Take on the Teachers' in a TT Rockstars battle! There will also be awards for the children and classes who have shown the greatest improvement with their times tables over the course of the week.

Please do not go to any expense for a rockstar costume. A simple costume can be made with jeans, a t-shirt and a piece of material for a bandana.

I know all the children love playing 'Times Table Rockstars' and will thoroughly enjoy a week of times tables activities.
