## **FS2 visit to Tropical Butterfly House - Wildlife and Falconry Centre Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> July 2026**

Dear families,

As part of this half term's focus, we are finding out about life cycles in our Topic 'Big Wide World'. On **Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> July 2026**, we will be taking the children from **Foundation Stage 2 (Ladybirds and Gruffalos)** to the **Tropical Butterfly House**.

We will be leaving school at 9.20 am and we will be arriving back at school for approximately 3.00 pm so the children should be collected at the usual time from their classrooms.

The children will be expected to wear their school uniform. However, it is suggested that they should wear comfortable/sensible footwear, for example either school shoes or trainers. As the weather can be unpredictable, please ensure your child has a sun hat and cream and a waterproof coat with them as some of the activities will take place outside.

You will need to send your child with a separate water bottle to use throughout the day as a drink will not be provided by school. The children will need a small rucksack to be able to carry their water bottles, sun cream and light raincoats in.

If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium Grant, there is a discount, and the amount is reduced to **£12.75**.
