LKS2 Conkers Trip

Wednesday 24th June 2026

Dear Parents /Carers,

As part of our Geography work, we have arranged a day trip to Conkers on **Wednesday 24th June** for **Year 3 and 4**. At Conkers we will be exploring the great outdoors and taking part in activities that will support us with our outdoor learning.

We plan to **leave school at around 9.00 am on Wednesday 24th June**. The children should arrive at school for the normal time of **8.30 am** to be registered in class before we depart. We aim to be back at school **before the end of the school day**, so please pick up your child as usual at **3.25 pm**. If there is a chance that we will arrive any later than this time, we will inform you via ClassDojo.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£18** towards the coach and this exciting outdoor adventure. If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium Grant, there is a discount of 25% and the contribution is **£13.50**. Please log in to ParentPay to make payment and give permission for your child to attend.

Children should wear their normal school uniform for this trip. However, they can wear sensible footwear for the outdoors such as comfortable flat shoes and trainers. Your child should also bring a **packed lunch and water bottle** with them on the day. **A free packed lunch can be provided for all children in receipt of Free School Meals. Please let the school office know by Thursday 11th June if you would like to order one for your child.** If the weather is hot, children will also need a sun hat and should arrive at school wearing sun cream. However, a light waterproof coat may also be useful depending on the weather on the day. It would be useful to bring these items in a rucksack so they can carry their things around more easily.

If your child suffers with travel sickness or has any medical conditions/ allergies that we are not already aware of, please make the class teacher aware. You will also need to speak to the office if your child needs any medication during this visit.
