## **KS1 Visit to Magna Science Adventure Centre Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> March 2026**

Dear Parent/Carer

Our children in Key Stage 1 will be visiting Magna Science Adventure Centre on Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> March. We will be leaving school at around 9.00 am, so children will need **to arrive at school for 8.40 am**. We will be returning to school at around **3.00 pm** ready for our usual collection time. If there is a chance that we will return any later than this time, we will inform you via ClassDojo. Please ensure that your child is wearing their school uniform as usual for this trip. However, they may wish to wear alternative footwear, such as trainers, as there is some walking involved.

As all Key Stage 1 children receive universal infant free school meals, school will provide a packed lunch for all children on this visit so you will not need to send your child with any lunch on this day. Children will need **a drink for lunchtime AND a bottle of water for the day**. Children will be expected to carry their own things during the day so they will need to bring these items in a suitable small bag or rucksack as this will make it much easier for children to carry.

We are asking for a voluntary contribution of £17 towards the cost of the trip. If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium Grant, there is a discount of 25% and the contribution is £12.75. This includes transport and entry to Magna. **There will be no need for any spending money.**

Please log into ParentPay to make payment and to give permission for your child to take part.

Please speak to the School Office if your child will need any medication during this visit, e.g. travel sickness pills or inhalers and let your child's class teacher know if there is anything else they need to know in relation to this trip.
